### **What is Campaign SightFirst II (CSFII)?**

Campaign SightFirst II is a coordinated, global fund-raising effort involving all 1.4 million Lions in 46,000 clubs to raise US\$150 million for the SightFirst program. It is being conducted by the LCIF, the grant-making arm of the International Association of Lions Clubs.

### **The SightFirst Program**

In the past 15 years, Lions have done more to prevent blindness and restore sight than in their previous 65 years as "knights of the blind." In a decade-and-a-half, Lions have prevented severe vision loss or restored sight to **24 million people**. **SightFirst makes it possible.**

**SightFirst** has touched the lives of tens of millions around the globe. Through SightFirst, Lions are changing the world – and the world now looks to Lions as leaders in the international effort to combat preventable blindness.

Our newest lion member Bob Niederkorn has agreed to be a district club coordinator for SightFirst II working as an intermediate with other clubs. Thanks Bob.
