## **Leader Dog for the Blind and Lions International Headquarters Trip**

After a lot of thought and careful listening to others lions, there WILL BE a trip to Leader Dog for the Blind. Lion Bunny Talbot of Little Falls, and I have been working on this and we think we have a reasonably priced trip for the multiple to go to Leader Dog in Rochester MI. The dates we are thinking of are April 19/22, which are after lent. We would start in Brainerd, with stops in Little Falls, St Cloud, Rogers, Maple Grove, and St. Paul on So. Robert. Then down to Owatonna, with Albert Lea being the last pick up point. We would spend the night in the Rockford IL area, at a Comfort Inn. Tour Lions International Headquarters, which takes about an hour and a half, get back on the bus, head to Rochester MI. area, and spend the night there. Tour Leader Dog, which is a couple of hours, get back on the bus and head home. We will have one more night out and that will be in Tomah WI, at the Comfort Inn. Then Sunday, into Minnesota and start dropping everyone off in the proper cities. We figure we can do this for about \$260.00 per person. That would be 2 people to a room for the over nights. If you don't want to share a room it will be more. The rooms will be the Comfort Inn type, which has a continental breakfast bar. We have tried to keep expenses to a minimum, yet have everything covered. I think that we've done that. The lunches and dinners are your expense. We will need a down payment of \$150.00, as soon as possible, to hold your spot, with the rest due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of March. We are limited to space so the first 46 people that call will have a space held. Please talk it up with in your district.
